Bruce Jett Associates collaborated with Jon Worden Architects and Ross Construction to develop one of the last remaining developable sites in the heart of downtown Palo Alto. Design for this multi-use residential project included two public plazas at the corners of Channing and Homer Avenues, four courtyards forming sequential greenspaces along the back Alley and streetscaping along High Street.

Each courtyard design is intended to be unique through the selection of plant materials, paving patterns and color and water effects. Many of the planter seatwalls will screen the private courtyards and also define the length of the cascading angular water features. The water features will provide visual focus from the upper level stairs on the east side of the courtyard and from the long axis from the central corridor.

The design response for this project addressed the many technical challenges of landscaping over structures while creating individualized public and private open space. Construction 2004.
